A pergola is an outdoor feature that provides an open structure and shade for your space. The "roof" of the pergola can be left open or covered to create an area sheltered from the elements.

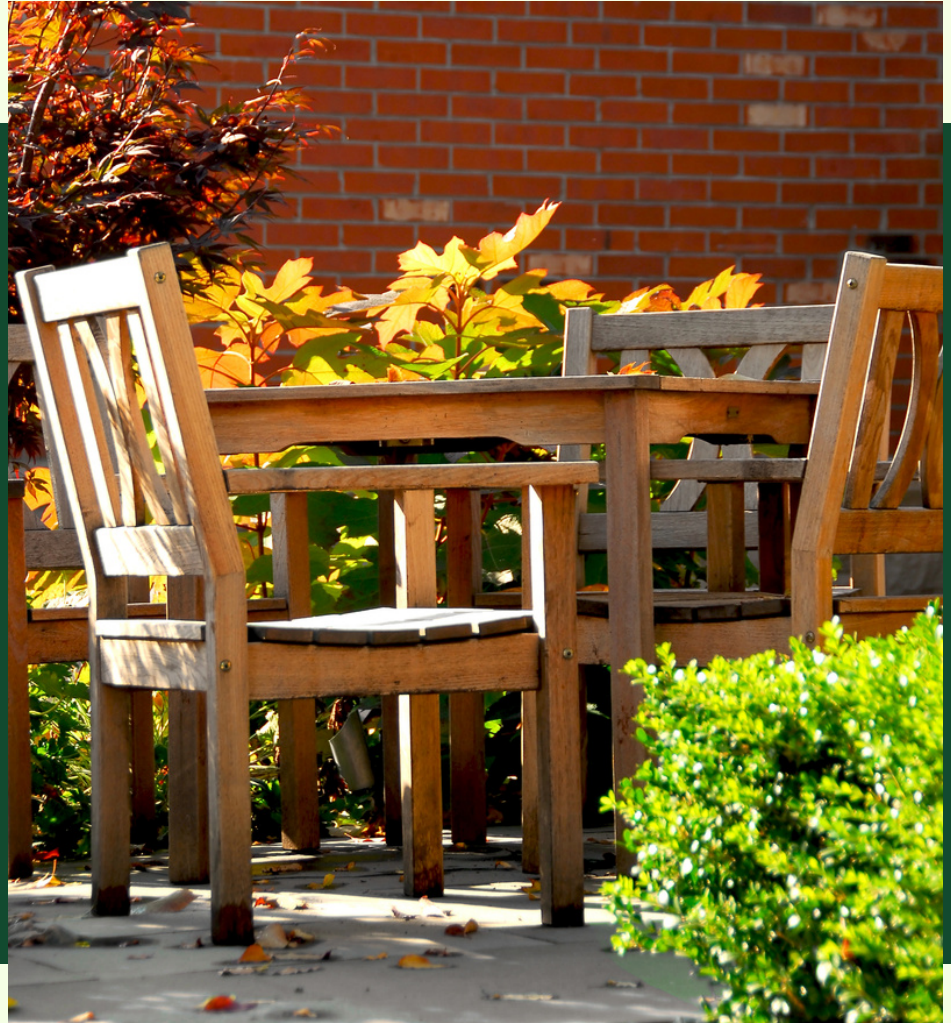


FIRE PIT

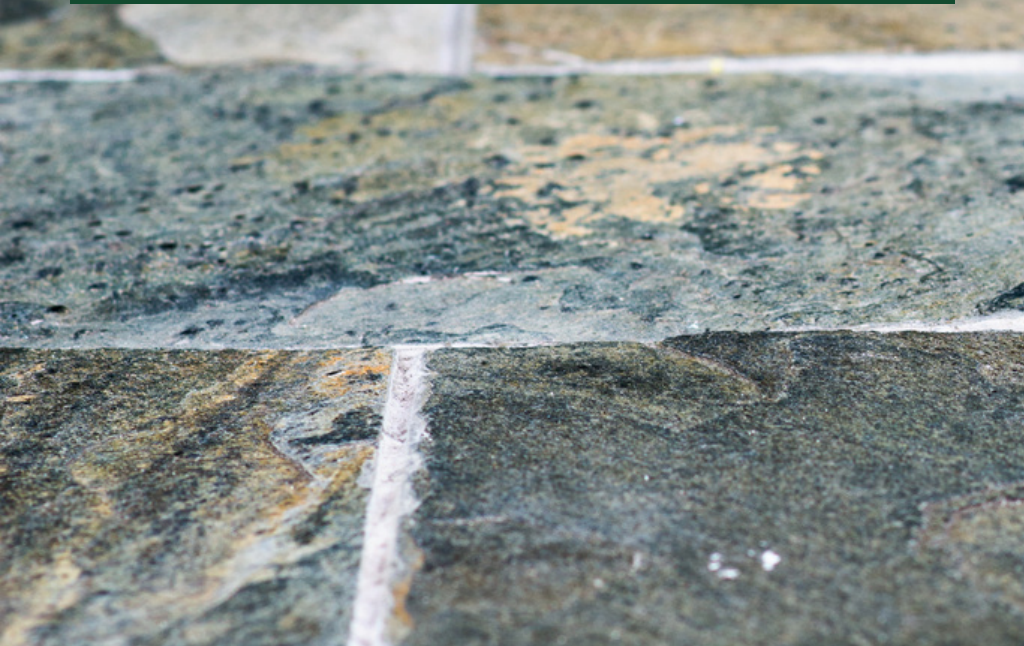
BRICK
